DOT Physical - \$100 to \$150 DOT Drug Screen - \$50 to \$60

MVR - \$8.75

Learner's Permit - \$36.25 CDL License Class A - \$66.25

Each course consists of six (6) weeks

Items Needed to Register for Class:

- 1. Current/Valid Alabama Driver License
- 2. DOT Physical Medical long form and medical certificate
- 3. CDL Learner's Permit
- 4. TAT Certificate (Truckers Against Trafficking)
- 5. DOT Drug Test Results (negative results) must be dated within 30 days of class date
- 6. MVR (Motor Vehicle Report) must be dated within 30 days of class date
- 7. Be at least 18 years of age

Note: All items must be completed and turned in one week prior to the 1st day of class.

Drug Screen results & MVR report must be dated within 30 days of the start of class.

All students are subject to random alcohol & drug screening during the course of the 6-weeks.

No High School Diploma or GED required
